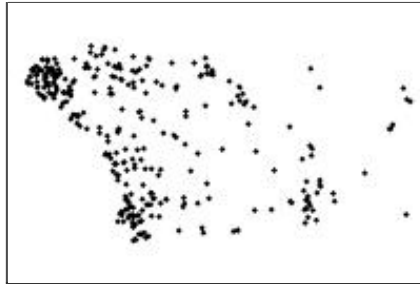

SWISNO is a unique identification number assigned to a specific facility, site or operation.

UNITNO is a unit number that is an arbitrary number, but unique, assigned to a unit for a specific facility.

SITENAME is the name of the site

COUNTYID is County ID

COUNTY is the name of the county the waste facility is in.

OPERATOR is the person, party, company, corporation, etc. that is the operator/business owner of the activities (permitted or otherwise) occurring at the facility, site, operation.

LOCATION is the Physical Location or Address

PLACENAME is the nearest city or town from the site

ZIP is the Zip Code

ENFORAGENT is Enforcement Agency (EA). The entity responsible for enforcing solid waste handling laws and regulations

OWNER is a classification of each owner/operator by their economic sector

CATEGORY is the type of waste handled ACTIVITY is the specific waste handling practice that is regulated by the CIWMB

ACTIVITY is the specific waste handling practice that is regulated by the CIWMB

REGSTATUS is Regulatory Status; the state of a particular waste handling facility

OPSTATUS is Operational Status; the state of waste handling activities

LATITUDE is the latitude positional descriptor of facility in decimal degrees

LONGITUDE is longitude positional descriptor of the facility in decimal degrees

SITEID is the Site identification number

UNITID is the identification number of the type of waste handled

__FID (OID)

Internal feature number.

SWISNO (String)

SWISNO is a unique identification number assigned to a specific facility, site or operation. It comprises eight characters and is divided into three parts having

the form "XX-YY-ZZZZ". The first two characters are numbers that represent the County in which the facility is located. The second two are alpha characters and is a code used by a particular LEA or Board Program. The last four characters are numbers generated by the database.

UNITNO (Double)

UNITNO is a unit number that is an arbitrary number, but unique, assigned to a 'unit' for a specific facility. A unit is a waste handling activity associated with a facility. For any facility there will be least one unit, assigned the unit number "01"; additional units would be assigned numbers in ascending sequence, e.g., unit "01" green waste composting; unit "02" material recovery; unit "03" a closed waste disposal cell, all at the same facility. Refer to Chapter 2 of the SWIS User's Manual for more information. See also: Activity, and Characterization Scheme.

OPERATOR (String)

OPERATOR is the person, party, company, corporation, etc. that is the operator/business owner of the activities (permitted or otherwise) occurring at the facility, site, operation. This is defined on the Solid Waste Facility application/permit.

LOCATION (String)

The physical description of the area, location, street, road, etc. where the facility, site or operation is to be found. Do not use P.O. Box, assessor's parcel number (APN) or township-range. (Please put P.O. Box, APN, etc. in the site comment box.).

PLACENAME (String)

PLACENAME is the nearest city or town from the site. Places have

characteristics of Place Type, latitude and longitude. All places are associated with a particular solid waste Enforcement Agency.

ZIP is the Zip Code

ENFORAGENT (String)

ENFORAGENT is Enforcement Agency (EA). The entity responsible for enforcing solid waste handling laws and regulations in a particular jurisdiction in the state. EA usually refers to the CIWMB acting where there is no Local Enforcement Agency (PRC 40130).

OWNER (String)

OWNER is Owner/Operator Type. A way of classifying each owner/operator by their economic sector; since permits are issued to persons operating facilities, rather than facilities, this scheme also is a way of classifying permits; types include: -- City: a representative of an incorporated city of the state; -- County: a representative of one of the counties of the state; -- District: a representative of a special district of the state, e.g., school district, flood control district; -- Federal: a representative of the federal government, excluding military; -- Indian: a representative of a recognized native American tribe; -- Military: a representative of the US military, reserves or state national guard; -- Private: a representative of private, independent business; - State: a representative of state government, excluding state military.

CATEGORY (String)

CATEGORY is a set of waste management activities that are related through similar waste handling methods. Categories include: Transfer/Process, Composting, Transformation, Disposal, Waste Tire Site.

ACTIVITY (String)

ACTIVITY is the specific waste handling practice that is regulated by the CIWMB.

A solid waste facility or site or operation may include one or more waste handling activities(units). Activities include: Large Volume Transfer Station, Small Volume Transfer Station, Medium Volume Transfer Station and Processing Facility, Limited Volume Transfer Operation, Sealed Container Transfer Operation, Direct Transfer Facility, Emergency Transfer and Processing Operation, Treatment Unit (processing), Materials Recovery Facility (MRF), Composting Facility (Yard Green), Composting Facility (Other), Composting Facility (Animal), Composting Facility (Sludge), Composting Facility (Mixed), Composting Operation (Ag), Composting Operation (Research), Transformation Facility, Solid Waste Landfill, Land Application, Treatment Unit (in situ), Solid Waste Disposal Site, Wood Waste Disposal Site, Major Waste Tire Facility, Minor Waste Tire Facility, Waste Tire Location, Tire Monofill Disposal Site, Tire Dealer, Tire Retreader, Auto Dismantler, Inert

Waste Disposal Site, Contaminated Soil Operation@Transfer, Contaminated Soil Facility@Disposal, ACW Disposal Site, Nonhazardous Ash Transfer/Processing, Nonhazardous Ash Disposal/Monofill, Emergency Construction and Demolition/Inert Debris Processing Operation, Inert Debris Processing Facility, Inert Debris Type A Processing Operation, Large Volume Construction and Demolition Wood Debris Chipping and Grinding Facility, Large Volume Construction and Demolition/Inert (CDI) Debris Processing Facility, Medium Volume Construction and Demolition/Inert (CDI) Debris Processing Facility, Small Volume Construction and Demolition Wood Debris Chipping and Grinding Operation, Small Volume Construction and Demolition/Inert (CDI) Debris Processing Operation. REGSTATUS (String)

REGSTATUS is Regulatory Status; The state of a particular waste handling facility, operation or site with respect to the requirements that the waste handling activities are to be conducted under the terms and conditions of a permit, closure plan, never been required to have a permit, or currently not required to have a permit. Statuses include: Proposed, Permitted, Unpermitted, Exempt, Suspended, Revoked, Surrendered, Pre-Regulations, Excluded, Notification, Not Currently Regulated, To Be Determined.

OPSTATUS (String)

OPSTATUS is Operational Status; the state of a waste handling facility, operation or site with respect to its ability to conduct waste handling activities. Statuses include: Planned, Active, Inactive, Closing, Closed, Abandoned, Cleaned Closed, To Be Determined, Absorbed.

LATITUDE (Double)

The angular distance, north or south of the equator, measured in degrees along a meridian, as on a map or globe. Refer to Chapter 2 of the SWIS User's Manual for instructions on how to enter this data.

The distances in these cells are expressed in decimal degrees.

LONGITUDE (Double)

LONGITUDE is the angular distance on the earth or on a globe or map, east or west of the prime meridian at Greenwich, England. Refer to Chapter 2 of the SWIS User's Manual for instructions on how to enter this data. The distances in these cells are expressed in decimal degrees.
